When I was growing up Dee's and the DeeBurger Clown was a cultural Icon in Utah. There were 54 drive ins and restaurants. The first Dee's was opened in the 1920's It was known for its family-friendly advertising and the colorful "Dee's Clowns" that adorned its restaurants, In the late 1970 the Hamburger chain was sold to Hardees They kept the restaurants.
